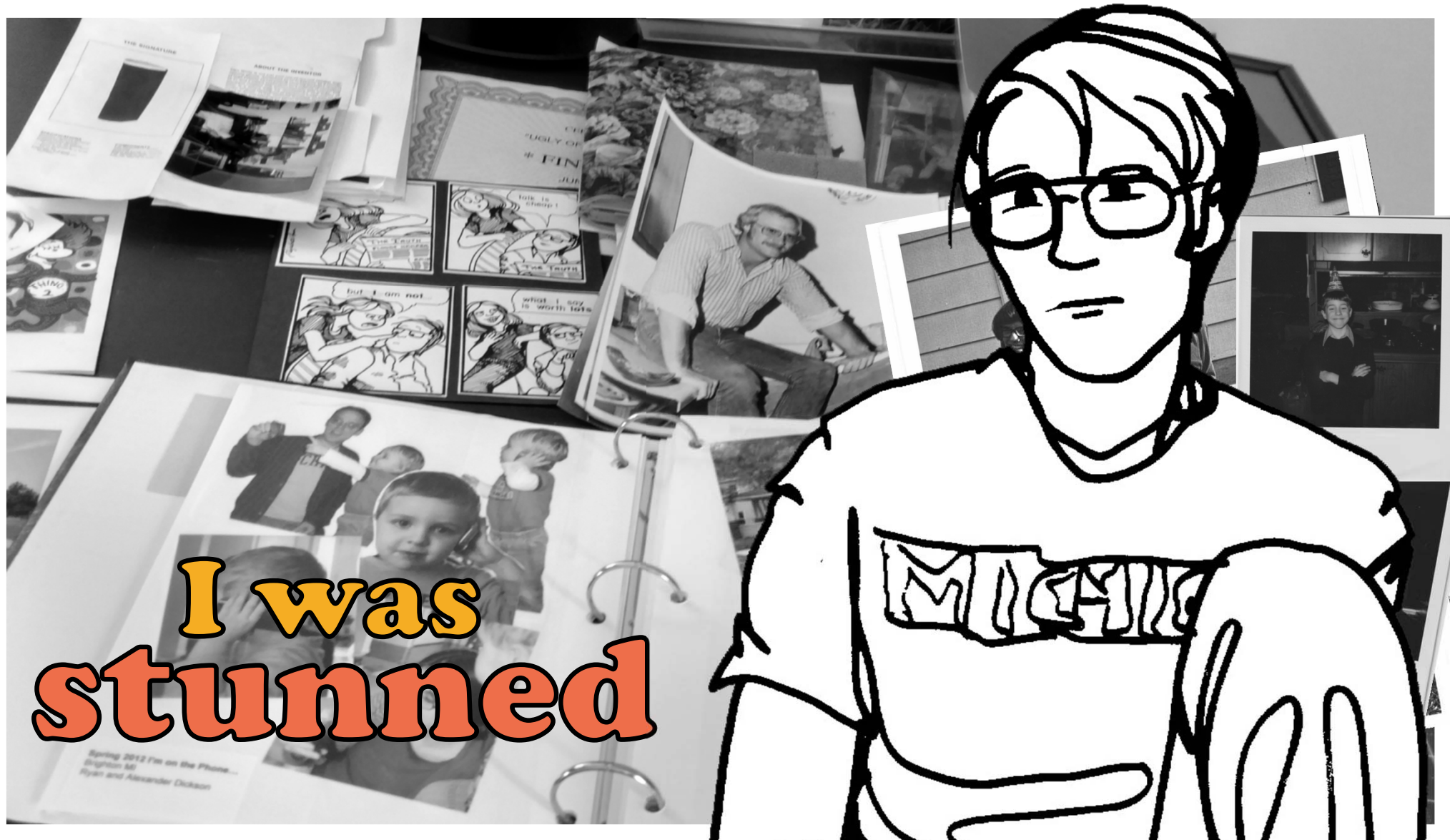
We were sitting

skeptic



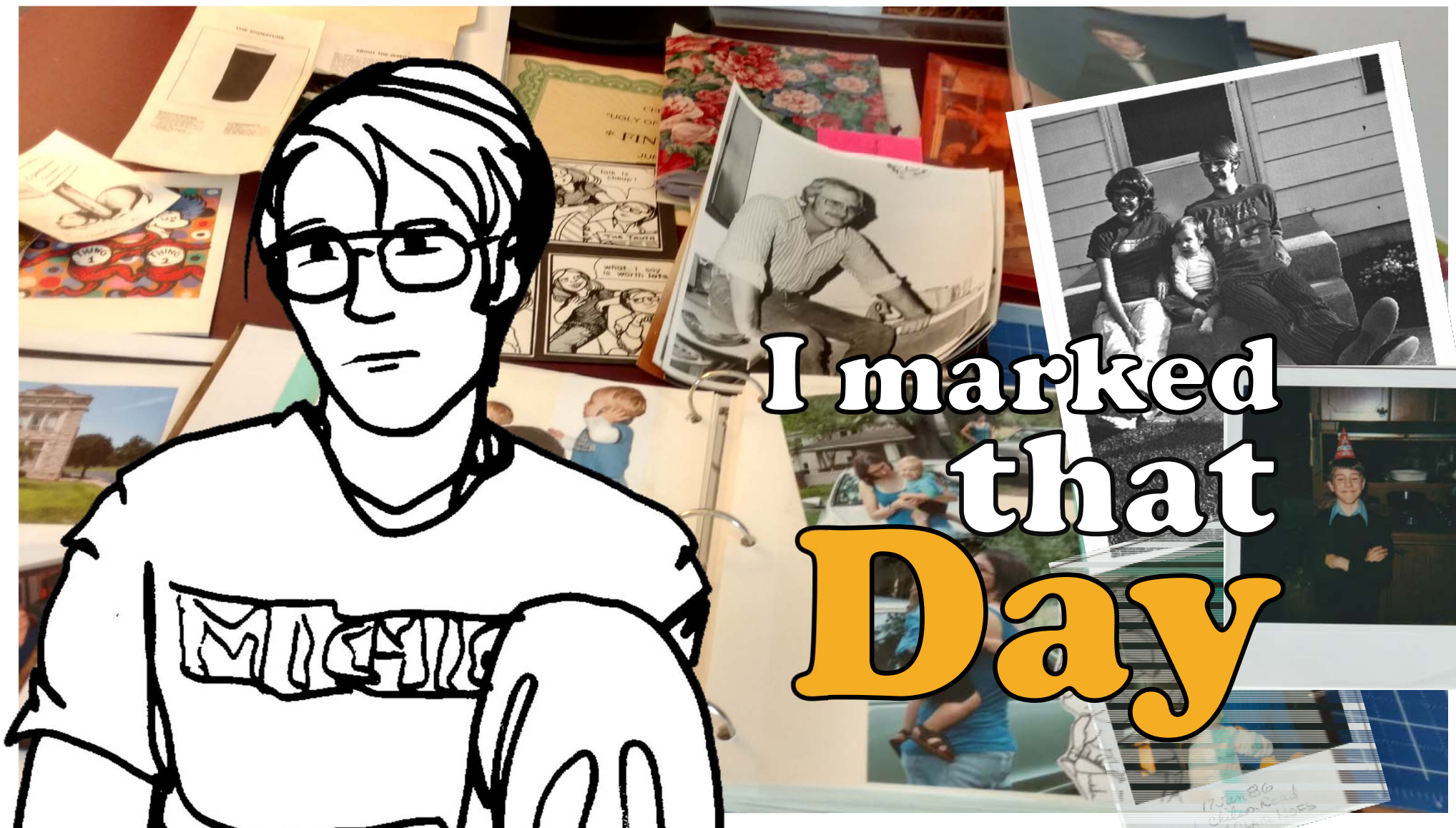
I was
